



Before You Fly

- ☐ Passport valid for at least 6 months beyond your arrival date task
- ☐ Complete the free iDeclare form at ideclare.gov.bz before flying
- ☐ Carry proof of onward or return travel (airline ticket or itinerary)
- ☐ Carry proof of sufficient funds for your stay
- ☐ Child traveling without both parents? Bring notarized parental consent + copies of both parents' IDs

Money & Essentials

- ☐ Small USD or BZD bills ready for day-one expenses (ATMs may not be immediately available)
- ☐ Cash for land border exit fees if entering overland (Mexico or Guatemala border)
- ☐ Travel insurance card – printed copy and saved on your phone
- ☐ Prescription medications in original labeled packaging with written dosage summary
- ☐ Offline maps downloaded before you leave Wi-Fi (Google Maps or Maps.me)

Customs – What Not to Bring

- ☐ No coral, turtle products, or protected marine items – illegal to possess
- ☐ No beer, wine and spirits are allowed within duty-free limits only
- ☐ Declare all plants, meat, and dairy at customs – undeclared items can be seized
- ☐ No archaeological artifacts or antiques without a government license
- ☐ Items above duty-free thresholds must be declared on arrival
